<i>Acer palmatum</i>	Japanese maple	2	Select variety for green foliage, upright form & sun tolerance; especially recommend <i>A.p. 'Seriyu'</i> or <i>A. japonicum 'Aconitifolium'</i>
<i>x Cupressocyparis leylandii</i>	Leyland cypress	7	Viewcrest to supply
<i>Cornus kousa</i>	Kousa (Korean) Dogwood	1	Alternative: native <i>C. nuttallii</i> hybrid 'Starlight', 'Venus' or 'Eddie's White Wonder'
SHRUBS			
<i>Choisya ternata</i>	Mexican orange	7	Species or cultivar 'Aztec Pearl' NOT 'Sunburst'
<i>Cornus sericea 'Midwinter Fire'</i>	Midwinter Fire dogwood	7	Stunning apricot-orange-red winter twigs
<i>Ribes sanguineum</i>	Red-flowering currant	2	Species or any cultivar
<i>Rosa 'Flower Carpet Amber'</i>	Amber groundcover rose	15	Cheaper alternatives but less showy: <i>Escallonia 'Newport Dwarf'</i> or <i>Potentilla 'Red Ace'</i>
FERN & GRASSES			
<i>Helictotrichon sempervirens 'Sapphire'</i>	Sapphire blue oat grass	20	Bluer, more compact variety
<i>Liriope muscari 'Monroe White'</i>	White lilyturf / lirioppe	20	
<i>Phormium 'Flamingo'</i>	Flamingo New Zealand flax	2	Compact variety only; alternative 'Evening Glow'
<i>Polystichum munitum</i>	Western sword fern	7	
GROUNDCOVERS			
<i>Epimedium grandiflorum</i>	Longspur Epimedium	n/a	Divide and plant small clumps or runners 18-24" apart
<i>Fragaria chiloensis</i>	Barren strawberry	36	Space 18" apart. Do not substitute pink variety like 'Lipstick'
