

GENERAL SPECIFICATIONS FOR GAME COURT SITE PREPARATION – using Sport Base

FRAMING: The area should be framed to retain the fill material, SportBase and court surface. The interior area of the frame should be the overall court size. A recommended material for framing is 4" x 6" pressure treated timber.

GRADE:

- 1. Area must be excavated and fine graded to a **0% grade** (flat).
- 2. A layer of landscaping fabric should be installed.
- 3. We require that a **minimum of 3"** of crushed rock (5/8"clean or minus) be added to the entire area and compacted.
- 4. Another layer of landscaping fabric should be installed.
- 5. An additional **minimum of 1"** of smaller crushed rock (e.g. ¼" minus or smaller) should be installed and compacted.
- 6. The finished area needs to be compacted and graded perfectly flat.
- 7. Please note that court surface height will be **2.5"** above the final grade height (unless otherwise specified).

DRAINAGE: If necessary, excess water **must be controlled with appropriate drainage** – the court area must also be free of any water before construction can begin.

ANCHOR SETTING: All lines (e.g. drainage, irrigation, power, cable, etc) must be **capped 2' away from the court location**. When staking or setting anchors, **Sport Court (Court Development Inc.) is NOT responsible for any damage to unmarked lines** – Please use a utilities locator service to locate any lines.

• Sport Court (Court Development Inc.) must approve all site preparation before court construction begins.
