I inspected the lot for significant trees and found two. A Japanese Maple with a 8.8" DBH and a Douglas Fir with a 32" DBH.

Tree #1 The Japanese Maple is in good condition with a dripline of 12'.

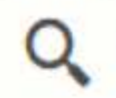
Tree #2 The Douglas Fir has poor taper. The DBH of this tree suggests what normally would be a much taller tree, this tree is 95' tall with a 20' dripline. The foliage on the tree has good color, but the crown is thinner than what would be normal. The top of the tree has been damaged and resprouted. English Ivy covers 25% of the tree. A higher level of inspection may expose inner weakness of the trunk.
