I thought of one more thing that I know I will need with your permit applications.

For the building permit, I'll need you to include the valuation of any portion of work that requires a building permit. I have to admit, I haven't spend much time looking at the plan, so I don't know which portions require the building permit.

Things like retaining walls and vaults typically require a building permit – so we'd need to know the valuation (estimated construction cost labor plus materials) of those kind of items. Let me know if this needs more clarification.
