GEO Group Northwest, Inc, has reviewed the construction plans for the above referenced project for their conformance with the geotechnical recommendations as presented in the above referenced geotechnical report. The plans we received consisted of the following:

- Plan set 7-14-2022
- Site Plan 11-1-2022

In our opinion, the reviewed plans are consistent with the geotechnical recommendations presented in the above referenced geotechnical report. Provided that the recommendations in these documents are properly implemented, it is our opinion the proposed development will not increase the potential for soil movement, and the risk of damage to the site or from the site to adjacent properties from soil instability will be minimal. Minimum risk does not mean no risk,


but that necessary design measures have been taken to reduce the level of risk to a low or minimal quantity.
