Hello Lauren,

Hopefully you have received my voicemail. This is the 3rd letter I am writing following each of the public notices which are sent for the upcoming projects relating to 3675 and other on West Mercer Way.

As indicated in my earlier communication, with the current waterfront project, we have been facing extreme situations on West Mercer Way around our driveway for the last 18 or more months. As indicated earlier, as the parked cars were totally blocking our view and could cause major accidents, working closely with the managers of the current construction projects, we were able to place permanent cones to give us visibility for oncoming traffic and clear the driveway to our mailboxes.

With the new permits posted, the concern is where are the construction worker cars going to park? We already have the main fire hydrant blocked every day as there are on the average about 25 cars each weekday. We also have no space left for the non construction related tenants to have vans or cars which can not fit in our driveway to park on west mercer way. Clearly the property owners are making no effort to solve this problem and I am concerned about even more cars parking- as we have no spaces. Also, WE WILL NOT be giving up the area we have blocked to give us visibility.

We expect our city to equally pay attention to our concerns as it does in issuing permits. We all have hopes and expectations from the City of Mercer Island. Appreciate your help on this.

I understand that concerns are due to you by June 30th. I am happy to come and meet with you or have you come by on a weekday to view this mess first hand. I am quite fed up with this mess and we as residents need equal access to public parking surrounding our houses. So not only our current problem needs to be resolved but we will not tolerate a bad situation getting far worse than it is now.

Many thanks. Let me know what venue works best for you as we want to make sure our concerns are noted pre the deadline.
