Permit Type: Type III

Description of Request: A request for SEPA review for a watercourse mitigation and restoration project. The proposal aims to restore and stabilize an unnamed watercourse in sub-basin 22.1 which has been eroding due to high flow.

Applicant: Fred Gu (City of Mercer Island)

Location of Proposal: Unnamed watercourse located on parcels 9365700140, 8057000014, and 9365700160, off West Mercer Way by 4230 block, NE 1/4, S13, T24N, R4E.

SEPA Compliance: Following review of the submitted State Environmental Policy Act (SEPA) checklist, an initial evaluation of the proposed project for probable significant adverse environmental impacts has been conducted. The City expects to issue a SEPA Determination of Non-Significance (DNS) for this project. The optional DNS process, as specified in Washington Administrative Code (WAC) 197-11-355, is being used. This may be your only opportunity to comment on the environmental impacts of the proposal. The proposal may include mitigation measures under applicable codes, and the project review process may incorporate or require mitigation measures regardless of whether an Environmental Impact Statement (EIS) is prepared. Only those persons who submit written comments or participate at the public hearing (if a hearing is required) will be parties of record; and only parties of record will have the right to appeal.

Public Hearing and Public Meeting: Pursuant to MICC 19.15.030 Table A and B a public hearing is not required for Type I-III permits.

Applicable Development Regulations: Applications for SEPA Threshold Determinations are required to be processed as Type III land use reviews pursuant to Mercer Island City Code (MICC) 19.15.030. Processing requirements for Type III land use reviews are further detailed in MICC 19.15.030.
