In consideration of Two hundred thirty-seven and no/100 (\$237.00) Dollars, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged the State of Washington, does hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto Emma C. Ketcham, her heirs and assigns the following described Tide and Shore land of the second class, situate in King County Washington to-wit:

All Tide and Shore lands of the second class, owned by the state of Washington, situate in front of adjacent to or upon that portion of the government meander line lying in front of Lot 1, Section 17, Township 24, North, Range 5 East of the Willamette Meridian, and having a total frontage of 23.70 lineal chains, measured along the meander line, according to a certified copy of the government field notes of the survey thereof on file in the office of the Commissioner of Public Lands at Olympia Washington,

To have and to hold the said premises with their appurtenances unto the said Emma C. Ketcham, her heirs and assigns forever.
