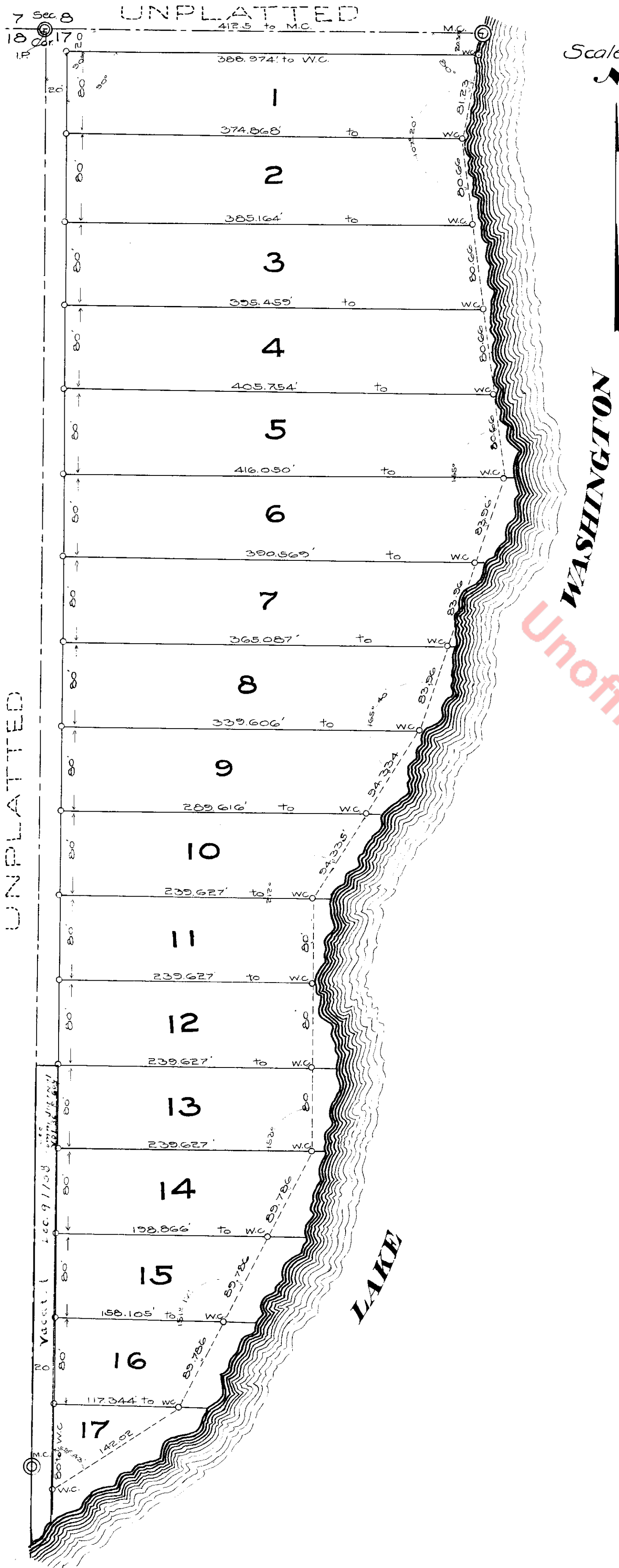


Plat of Lakeholm Addition

DESCRIPTION

This Plat of LAKEHOLM ADDITION embraces all of Lot One (1); Sec. 17; T. 24 N, R. 5 E. W.M.
 Posts marked W.C. are set on the side lines of all lots and are intended as witness posts to the true corners lying in LAKE WASHINGTON.
 All lot and street dimensions are as shown on plat.
 The Initial Point is the section corner common to Sec's 7, 8, 17 & 18.

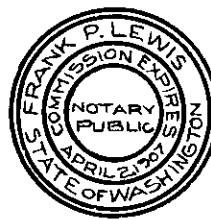
