DEED FOR EASEMENT AND RIGHT OF WAY

ANDREW RENFOW and LILY DENISON, his wife, Grantors, for and in consideration of the sum of One (\$1.00) Dollar in hand paid, receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, do hereby bargain, sell and convey to CARL STROUD and MARY E. STROUD, his wife, and THOMAS T. WATSON and LAURA L. WATSON, his wife, Grantees, a right of way and permanent easement for the purpose of laying, maintaining, operating and removing a pipeline two inches or less in diameter for transportation of water over and through the lands of the Grantors, situate in the County of King, State of Washington, and more particularly described as follows:

SEC. OF LOT 23 TWP. OR BLK 24 PARCELE 4, TL-10- BEG AT E¹ CCR OF SEC TV N 89°52'107" W ALG 1 SEC LN 1550' TO SW CCR OCV
LOT 3 TR S 3°03'53" E ALG MEAND LN 335.83' TO TRUE BEG TH
S 82°40'07" E 500' TR N 0°16'53" E 264.74' TH N 82°40'07"
" 636.3' TO SUCCE LINE "ASH". TH SELY ALG SD SHORE TO TRUE
ECC & SHORE LANDS ADJ LESS 3' 30' FOR RD

In the event that the adjacent portion of that road known as Forest Avenue Extension shall ever be deeded to the adjoining property owners by the County of King, said Grantors hereby bargain, sell and convey to said Grantees the permanent right to continue to maintain and operate the pipeline and pumping station will be situated thereon, in accordance with the right of way and easement granted by the County of King in the year 1941.

In consideration of the foregoing provisions, the Grantees covenant and agree that they will install three outlets, for the purpose of fire protection only, in the pipeline at points to be designated by Grantors.

The Grantees further covenant and agree that if the Grantors at some future date wish to join the water system, they shall be permitted to do so upon payment of 1/3 of the installation costs up to the point of service in the water system. If by the time they decide to join the system other homes than those of the present Grantees are serviced by the system, then their share of installation costs to the point of service shall be prorated according to the number of houses

service by said system. Following their joining said system, Grantors shall pay
equitable share of operating costs and maintenance up to their point of service.

The Grantees further covenant and agree to maintain the
signaling and pumphouse in a neat and presentable appearance and in repair at all
times and that in the event any repairs, replacements or maintenance are neces-
sary, then any ground or improvements disturbed or destroyed by the Grantees
shall be replaced or restored to the condition existing at the time of the com-
mencement of such maintenance or repair or replacement work as nearly as is pos-
sible so to do and all expense in connection therewith shall be paid by the Grantees.

The Grantees further covenant and agree to lay the pipeline
at a reasonable depth so as not to interfere with the use of the surface by the
Grantors.

The right of way and easement herein granted shall be apur-
tenant to Tracts 17 and 21, Harry White's lot of East Seattle are Tracts, ac-
cording to plat thereon recorded in Volume 7 of Plat,
County, Washington.
