## Description.

MERCER PARK, comprises all that part of lot 1 sections 1 Township 24 N. R. 4 East N. 1. West of a line parallel to and 524.5 ft West of the East boundary line of said section 1. Also the West 1/2 of the North East 1/4 of the North East 1/4, the South East 1/4 of the North East 1/4 of the North East 1/4 and the West 1/2 of the South East 1/4 of the North East 1/4. The North East 1/4 and the West 1/2 of the South East 1/4 of section 1 R. Township 24 North of Range 4 East N. 1. The Initial Point is a sand stone Monument at the intersection of the center line of Thompson Street with the West boundary of this plat. There are two other sand stone Monuments set as original monuments of this plat, both on the center line of Thompson Street, one being the North East corner of section 1 R and the other in a line between the Public Park and the section corner at 524.5 feet West of the section corner. All Quarrels and Streets except marginal ones are 60 feet wide each and are either parallel or at right angles to Thompson Street except Lake Avenue the bearing of which is determined by the lot measurements to the South thereof as indicated on the plat. All measurements are expressed in feet.

## Dedication.

Know Ye All, That we Louis F. Menage and Amanda A. Menage, his wife of Hennepin County, State of Minnesota, owners the fee simple of the land embraced in this plat of Mercer Park, do hereby declare this plat and dedicate to the use of the public forever as highways all the streets and avenues as shown hereon.
