Rebecca or Becky,

Thank you for your patience on the slip and permit for slip 37. I had a conversation with Betsy (Our Office Manager here at Shores that tracks all the boating stuff) and we had a conversation with Jay Lazzar who is the person that is renting that space from us. This is what we learned.

The spot was originally used by a Roger O'Connell. Roger went through Sunstream Boat Lifts in 1999 or 2000 to have the lift and cover installed. Sunstream said they did get and had approved permits for doing this. That slip and info should have been transferred over to Jay when he became the person to occupy that slip. There should be something with the City Of Mercer Island regarding this permit, slip, and Roger O'Connell as the original person. Now I know it is usually on the owner to provide proof but at the same time if the permit was issued by the city they should have a record of this. Even if it is not electronic which is my assumption here. They should have a hard paper copy of that record. If they do not, we are talking well over 20 years, I believe there should be some kind of grandfather clause that should apply here.

Can one of you, since you will be working with the permitting office, run this information by them and see what they say. I will be happy to go down there myself and have that conversation if you can point me in the right direction to do so.
