Forms are available from the Community Planning & Development department. Upon receipt of a timely complete [appeal application](#) and [appeal fee](#), an appeal hearing will be scheduled. To reverse, modify or remand a decision, the appeal hearing body must find that there has been substantial error; the proceedings were materially affected by irregularities in procedure; the decision was unsupported by material and substantial evidence in view of the entire record; or the decision is in conflict with the City's applicable decision criteria.
