

## Overview:


The proposed residential lots are within the Mercer Island School District and the following are the public schools of record for students within this short plat:

- Mercer Island High School . 9100 SE 42<sup>nd</sup>, Mercer Island WA 98040-4647


Starting this year, the Mercer Island School District is providing transportation service to all elementary students who live within their school boundaries and live 0.5 miles or more from the school they are enrolled in. They will provide bus transportation to and from Island Park Elementary School for the proposed address since it is 0.8 miles away from the school. Families should use the Parent Portal or Bus Quest App to request transportation to before and after-school programs at the Stroum Jewish Community Center or the Mercer Island Boys & Girls Club.



The Mercer Island School District is also providing transportation service for all Islander Middle School students who live on Mercer Island and live 0.75 miles or more from Islander Middle School. The proposed address is 2.3 miles away from Islander Middle School.



The Mercer Island School District will be providing its own yellow bus transportation service for all Mercer Island High School students who live on Mercer Island and live 1.0 mile or more from Mercer Island High School. The District has discontinued the King County Metro service. Mercer Island High School students will be able to ride one of the five District yellow buses to school or from school, but they must sign up for transportation. All buses will drop off and pick up on the bus pullout on 92nd Ave SE.
