 - Possibly quit claim?
 - Evan- who will maintain vault and property?
 - Jemae suggests City will maintain- no response
- Snethen Property
 - o Parcel too small to develop post construction per City code
 - o No access to parcel; driveway removed for roundabout construction
 - Dedicate to City?
 - o Evan- "quit claim"
 - Properties potentially go to MI (Real Prop or ROW?)
 - o Partick- both properties would be ROW appropriate
