## A. Land Use and Conveyance

- CUP- City is waiting for sample deeds for vault conveyance from other ST projects. City clarified they do not have a preferred method of conveyance.
   ROW Conveyance- ST stated that it intends to convey the two residential properties to City post-construction. ST cannot submit documents for these parcels until acquisition complete. ST clarified we do have letters from both property owners that we can apply for permits. Mercer Island staff indicated that the letters will suffice.

- <u>CUPConveyance of parcels to City</u>- City is waiting for sample deeds for <u>vault parcel</u> conveyance from other ST projects. <u>City staff requested it in meetings during the 60% and 90%</u> review processes. City clarified they do not have a preferred method offormat for conveyance document.

ROW Conveyance- ST stated that it intends to convey the two residential properties to City post-construction. ST cannot submit <u>deed/conveyance</u> documents for these parcels until acquisition complete. <u>ST stated that the acquisition is nearly complete</u>. <u>City staff indicated that conveyance request would have to be accepted by the City Council</u>. <u>There is no reason to believe it won't be accepted but it is a Council decision</u>. If not accepted, ST will need to obtain a conditional use permit.

Permit Applications for Parcels – City staff indicated that for the permit applications, ST will either need to show proof of ownership or a written acknowledgement from the owners authorizing ST to apply for permits. ST clarified we do have letters from both property owners that we can apply for permits. Mercer Island staff indicated that the letters will suffice for submittal of permit applications.

Thank you for the follow up communication.

I think the below approach makes sense in general, though the timing may require a bit of adjustment.
