I confirmed with her that I had located the record of the 2022 bite incident, but was unable to open her submitted photos as they were in a HEIC format. She agreed to text them to me along with a current picture of the wound she could take after the phone call. I advised as the evidence showed it was most likely a potentially dangerous dog declaration would be established and I explained the associated fines and restrictions this would include. <p>Investigation Memo 6/28/23 5 M23-450060 Entered by: MICCARLS</p>	<p>(pg 3) A23-003981 (MC36) 06/28/23 12:56  On June 28, 2023 at approx. 1210 hours I arrived at the suspect owner's home of 7510 SE 71st St Mercer Island WA 98040 and met with Mr. Brent Richard Irvin (650-289-8303   DOB: Jul 19, 1972). He invited me inside to discuss the incident in more depth. He confirmed his dog was on the back porch at the time Ms. Reiff was walking her dog on the street, when he heard his dog barking more vocally than is typical. His dog then ran down the stairs and left the property, breaking the barrier of the invisible fence and proceeded to bite Ms. Reiff. He admitted his dog's fault for running off as it had, but stated uncertainty of there being any injury to the victim. I showed him a picture on my phone that Ms. Reiff had sent me, confirming there was indeed a notable injury.  He stated the only incidents with his dog and violence were against this woman and he was unsure as to why. He explained on June 21, 2023 he had completed a drive to Arizona and deposited his dog in the care of his family and showed me a picture of the dog with his family's pets. He stated the dog was enrolled in a lengthy training and boarding facility to assist in correcting any of this behavior. He claimed the trainer expressed difficulty in training against aggression that was reportedly against only a single person or dog. He stated the dog was not expected to return for at least two months. Facility identified as Complete Transformations Dog Training (Tuscon, AZ   (520) 780-2720).  He stated he had tried communicating with the other party regarding this matter but found them non responsive and accused him of "victim blaming" when he suggested their dogs barking was triggering towards his. He claimed he had proposed bringing the two dogs together to interact in a controlled environment but the other owner was opposed to this. I did not respond to these suggestions but acknowledged them. He also claimed he informed her the dog was now in AZ but she had ceased communication.  I advised I would step outside and make phone contact with the victim to advise her of the dog's relocation.  &lt;CONT.&gt;</p>

I made phone contact with the reporting party and she stated she was unaware of the dog being moved out of state. I inquired as to her intentions with the outcome of this investigation, with the new knowledge of extensive training and the dog being relocated. She expressed uncomfotability with not proceeding with vicious animal. I asked if she could confirm the laceration she sustained was done by bite or claw and she was certain it was a bite. I zoomed in on her submitted photos and could plainly identify several puncture sites, consistent with a bite. I advised a violation for potentially dangerous dog would be submitted to Mercer Island courts.

I returned to Brent and advised him of this. He was very calm and understanding, accepting the charge but stating he would not allow his dog to be taken. We discussed containment procedures in accordance with potentially dangerous dog designations and the potential outcome of a reoffense during the 24 month review period once declared. He advised if the charge was upheld in an appeal he would likely have the dog remain with his family as he did not want to risk a reoffense, but stressed he and his family cared heavily for the dog and did not want to see that happen either.

I advised a letter of declaration would be sent to him via mail from Mercer Island courts with the associated infractions and he thanked me for my time. He advised he was open to communication with the other party to find a solution, such as announcing when she was on walks or establishing time blocks when the dog would not be outside, etc, but stated he would need a couple days before he would be productive in this conversation.

Additional phone contact made to reporting party to advise of outcome. Also informed her of his willingness to communicate, with some time between now and when this would happen.
