

DETERMINATION OF NON-SIGNIFICANCE (DNS)

Description of proposal:	Review under the State Environmental Policy Act (SEPA) to install vegetation and a trail system within the 25-foot buffer of a Type 2 stream. The trail construction would involve work up to the ordinary high water mark of the stream. The scope of this project also involves the reduction of the Type 2 stream's 50-foot buffer to 25 feet in order to construct an addition to a single-family residence, and the removal of a gravel pad within the stream's buffer.

You should be prepared to make specific factual objections. Contact the City Clerk to read or ask about the procedures for SEPA appeals. To reverse, modify or remand this decision, the appeal hearing body must find that there has been substantial error, the proceedings were materially affected by irregularities in procedure, the decision was unsupported by material and substantial evidence in view of the entire record, or the decision is in conflict with the city's applicable decision criteria.
