After talking to our senior planner, Kenny Booth, here are responses to questions raised in our Thursday call.

1)We plan to submit a concept-level plan with our CAR and reference Berger's landscape plan for the plant schedule. Our concept plan will need to include the agreed upon native plant species list and sizes/quantities for trees, shrubs and groundcover plants for the mitigation area only. We have coordinated with landscape architects on other projects in a similar fashion.

2)The code does not prohibit the use of native no-mow grass as a native groundcover. You can certainly propose it. 3)Mercer Island code doesn't specify plant spacing/density requirements. It's not unusual for similar sized shoreline lots to include 2-3 trees near the property edges. For reference, City of Sammamish requires 1 tree for every 500 SF and 1 shrub for every 25 SF. If we use that as a benchmark, this 1,560 SF mitigation area would need 3 trees and 63 shrubs. [Note: You could propose slightly fewer shrub since it's not specified in code. 30 SF spacing would reduce the shrub quantity to 52, for example.] I'd recommend adding some groundcover container plants to non-grass areas, such a sword fern and coastal strawberry. I'm open to suggestions from Berger on groundcover container plant quantities. If I assume about a third-to-half the mitigation includes groundcover container plants at 4-ft on-center spacing, that'd require about






